Newport Fishermen's Wives is proud to announce the **Newport Wild Seafood Weekend NWSW**, September 11 & 12 at Port Dock 7 and on Newport's Boardwalk – Newport.

This two day event will feature the third annual *Great Newport Wild Seafood Cook-Off* on Saturday and the first Wild Seafood Public Market on Sunday. All weekend there will be vendors along the boardwalk, participating fishermen selling off their boats at the dock of the Wild Fish Walk, a gear display area and a children's area. *Seafood Oregon* will be present educating the public about Oregon's Seafood, while handpicked Chefs prepare wild seafood samples of fish caught by Newport based fishermen at the Great Newport Wild Seafood Cooking School. Rogue Ales will be on site with their beer garden to compliment the public's experience.

Newport Fishermen's Wives' objective is to showcase Newport's working waterfront and diverse commercial fishing fleet while fundraising for their Fishing Family Relief Fund. The fishing community is invited to share in the opportunity to support and help underwrite the festival.
